The project involved adding an additional floor inside the existing facility, while it continued to operate. The renovation provides the Chaska community with a comprehensive wellness center that demonstrates how great design can maximize the use of existing space.

Chaska Community Center has been growing since the first building went up on site and now includes an ice arena, a community center, raised track, indoor water park and swim center, health and fitness facilities, and daycare facilities. The brick clad building is two stories and has a red standing seam roof and is a structural steel frame. There is also indoor tennis inside the building.
